

Addendum to the 2023 Mass Advantage Plus (HMO) Evidence of Coverage, Annual Notice of Changes and Summary of Benefits

Effective April 1, 2023, what you pay for Medicare Part B prescription drugs is changing. You currently pay a 15% coinsurance for drugs covered under Medicare Part B (primarily those that are administered by a healthcare provider). As of April 1, 2023, your coinsurance may vary by drug and may vary throughout the plan year, but will never be more than 15%. The information below shows you where the information about your Medicare Part B prescription drug coverage appears in your Evidence of Coverage (EOC), Annual Notice of Changes (ANOC) and Summary of Benefits.
